NAMIBIANS DON'T TRUST THEIR GOVERNMENT



Trust Levels in 2012

Namibia stood out for high institutional trust compared to other African countries surveyed for Round 5 of Afrobarometer.

Institution	Trust Level
President (Pohamba)	81%
National Assembly	74%
National Council	61%
Regional Council	66%
Local Authority Council	61%
Police	75%
Courts	75%
Traditional Leaders	65%

Trends Since Round 5

Later rounds (especially Round 9 and 10) show **declining trust**, particularly in legislative bodies:

- ▼ Recent Findings (2024 Round 10)
 - Trust in the National Assembly has sunk to a new low, alongside declining performance ratings.
 - Citizens express frustration with service delivery, especially in health care and job creation.
 - Corruption perceptions have worsened, with many believing the government is not doing enough to fight it.

Trust Deficit

Round 10 of Afrobarometer found that ...

62% of Namibians feel the country is going in **THE WRONG** DIRECTION.

The Credibility Gap

Round 8 of Afrobarometer found that:

 More than 1 in 2 Namibians (54%) of Namibians felt that government officials sometimes or often knowingly spread false information

– More than 1 in 2 Namibians (59%) strongly believed that information held by government should be shared with the public

Concerns About Governance

• The data suggests a disconnect between democratic ideals and institutional performance.

 Citizens want democracy, but they don't trust the institutions meant to uphold it.

Why Is Trust Declining?

 Perceived inefficiency, corruption, and lack of responsiveness are key drivers.

Citizens feel disconnected from national leaders and institutions.

Building Trust in Government Communication

Building trust in government communication requires more than just delivering information ... it demands transparency, empathy, responsiveness, and clarity.
